



AZEVEDO WATER POLO TRAINING TRIP CONTRACT & CODE OF CONDUCT

PART I – GENERAL CONTRACT STIPULATIONS

1. All participating team members and parents/chaperones/coaches will abide by this contract & code of conduct.
2. Full payment for the trip shall be completed before departure, unless otherwise agreed upon in writing by both parties.
3. Any cancellations regarding trainings or games must be announced at least 24 hours in advance. Failure to do so will result in a fine of 100 Euro.
4. Any cancellations made in regard to activities or outside trips must be announced at least 24 hours in advance. Failure to do so will result in full financial responsibility for the missed event on part of the team.
5. All trip participants, including parents, chaperones & coaches are responsible for their own overseas insurance and healthcare coverage.

PART II – ATHLETE CODE OF CONDUCT RULES

1. Use of alcoholic beverages is unacceptable at any AWP event, including meals or outings.
2. Use of drugs other than prescribed by a physician is unacceptable at any time during an AWP training trip.
3. AWP is not responsible for any situations that arise from non-AWP events during the trip.
4. Curfews and rules set by the AWP Trip Leader at any AWP sponsored event and at all related activities will be obeyed. Curfew is not enforced if participant is with parents.
5. Disrespectful, indiscreet or destructive behavior will not be tolerated. It is the responsibility of each athlete to make every effort to avoid guilt by association with such activities at any time during the year.

PART III – PARENT/CHAPERONE/COACH CODE OF CONDUCT RULES

1. Parents, chaperones & coaches should not provide the athletes with (or approve the consumption of) alcohol or illegal substances at any AWP event, including team dinners & parties.
2. Use of drugs other than those prescribed by a physician is unacceptable at any time during an AWP training trip.
3. Disrespectful, indiscreet or destructive behavior will not be tolerated. It is the responsibility of each parent, chaperone or coach to make every effort to avoid guilt by association with such activities at any time during the year.

PART IV- VIOLATION OF THE CODE OF CONDUCT RULES

At the discretion of the AWP Trip Leader any one or all of the following penalties will be applied:

1. Athlete may be banned from the further trainings and AWP events.
2. Athlete may be sent home immediately from practice or event at his own expense and if there is extra expense it will be athlete's responsibility.

I, herby agree to abide by the rules of conduct as set forth in Part I above and acknowledge that, should I violate any provision in Part I, I will be subject to disciplinary action, as set forth in Part II, including suspension.
